

Javier A. Chavez, PhD

Javier Chavez, a Peruvian-American citizen, was born in Peru but was raised in different countries due to his father's missionary work. At age 19 Javier immigrated to the U.S. to acquire higher education. He holds a Bachelor of Arts from Lee University (Cleveland, TN) in Religion and a minor in social studies, a Master of Arts degree from Wheaton College Graduate School (Chicago, IL) in Church History, and a PhD in Intercultural Studies at Biola University (La Mirada, CA). While at Wheaton, Javier met Noelia, and both got married in 2001.

In June of 2001, Javier and Noelia relocated to Peru where Javier served as church planter and pastor of Amistad Cristiana Lima until the end of 2013. In Lima, he founded Amistad Cristiana International, a missionary organization, through which a network of another 25 churches between autonomous congregations and local missions were planted, trained, and multiplied across Latin America. The Chavez's complemented their local church ministry working among the neediest families of Peru, reaching the poorest areas of the city of Lima, establishing feeding centers, developing after-school programs, providing spiritual assistance to many families, as well as involving each local community in the development of actions to improve the life of the community residents.

In January of 2015 the Chavez's relocated to Gainesville, GA where Javier worked for BB&T as a Hispanic Market Leader until the end of 2016, time in which he was called to full-time church planting and pastoral ministry with Amistad Cristiana Church (Gainesville, GA). Amistad Cristiana Gainesville is today the largest Hispanic congregation in northeast Georgia.

Javier is also an Ordained Minister in the Southern Baptist Convention since 2005. Javier has also served in denominational responsibilities as a GA Representative in the Southern Baptist Convention Committee on Committees in 2018, Executive Committee Member for the Georgia Baptist Convention (2019-2023), 2nd Vice-president of Georgia Baptist Convention (2019), Hispanic Representative for the Georgia Baptist Mission Board (2019-2020), Georgia Representative in the Hispanic Council for the Southern Baptist Convention (2020), and candidate for 2nd Vice President (2021) and for Recording Secretary (2022) in the Southern Baptist Convention.

Javier has been happily married to Noelia for twenty-two years and together they have four children: Joshua (21), Abigail (18), Vania (14), and Maximo Nathanael (11). Javier's passion is to build bridges among diverse ethnic communities while helping in the planting and leading of more multicultural congregations that effectively accomplish the Great Commission.
