PSM613 Advance Methods for Communicating the Bible Seminar: This course provides the student with an advanced look at communicating the Bible on the master's level. Various methods will be examined and assessed considering the method's effectiveness to faithfully communicate the Grammatical-Historical meaning of a text of Scripture. Application will be made to each of the Applied Theology disciplines including, preaching, teaching, counseling, leadership, and missions.

PSM102 Church Evangelism: An introduction to the development of a comprehensive church wide evangelistic ministry. Emphasis will be placed on developing, implementing and evaluating an effective outreach strategy, taking the local context into account.

BIB202 Survey of Bible Doctrines II: This course is a survey of basic Bible doctrines which focuses on the study of: Anthropology, Hamartiology, Soteriology, Ecclesiology, and Eschatology. Does not Satisfy Bible/Theological Requirements.

BIB302 Introduction to Systematic Theology II: The course will begin the student's study of Systematic Theology, emphasizing Anthropology, Hamartiology, Soteriology, Ecclesiology, and Eschatology.

APM631 Mentored Field Experience II: As a continuation of the first semester of Mentored Field Experience, students will build on the practical skills and understanding they have learned. Additionally in this course, students will develop and express a philosophy of ministry within the context of their ministerial position. Faculty will continue to provide oversight and guidance.
